MUNICIPAL CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATION





PROJECT MONITORING AND EVALUATION

To ensure the effectiveness of programs, projects and activities implemented by the municipality, the Office of the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator together with MEO conducted series of project monitoring and evaluation.

Also, the MPDC Staff conducted site inspection on the development done by the clients applying for Locational Clearance and Zoning Certificates. This is to ensure that the location is the same as in the submitted documents, as well as to measure if the setbacks were followed.







SITE INSPECTION

Aside from the above-mentioned accomplishments, the core services of this office are issuing Locational Clearance and Zoning Certificate. The Office of Municipal Plannina and Development issued Locational Clearances (LC), 233 Zoning Certifications (ZC) this year, as requested by clients. There is also a total of 27 request for Map. A locational clearance is one of the prerequisite documents before a person can secure a building permit. Usually, Mr. Reman Magada conduct the site inspection prior on releasing LC and ZC as it is basis if it conforms on the submitted development plan. essential to inspect the location as it ascertains compliance with project requirements.











PROJECT/ PROGRAM/ ACTIVITIES INSPECTION

In collaboration with the Engineering Office and Project Monitoring Team, the MPDO conduct a regular inspection of projects implemented by the LGU. Last year, the identified project of the under 20% Development Fundbarangays Development **Assistance** Community to Barangays is mostly an improvement/rehabilitation of Local Access Roads. The LGU believed thru these development projects the economy in the community will boost and will ease the lives of the Santafenhons. Various infrastructure projects were implemented in 2023 like Slaughterhouse, Multi-purpose cum Isolation Facility and there are continuing projects in the succeeding years.
