I - RICE PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The total area planted and reported for rice was 566.9 hectares both wet and dry cropping season tilled by 1,217 farmers. The same area has been harvested in years prior. The average yield per hectare obtained from inbred variety was 4.49 mt per hectare.

A. Site Validation for Bio Composting Facility

Last February 20, 2024, personnel of BSWM together with Regional Rice Staff and MAO Personnel conducted site validation which is suitable for Bio Composting Facility consist of Biocomposter and shredder. Luckily, 4 associations in the municipality of Santa Fe will receive that intervention intended for rice program.

B. Delivery And Distribution of Rice Seeds for Wet Season

Last May 16, 2024 the DA-LGU received 985 bags of certified inbred rice seeds from PhilRice under Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund (RCEF) containing 20 kgs/bag which is good for 267 hectares. It was utilized during **wet season** by 950 eligible rice farmers and reported as planted and harvested.



E. Delivery and Distribution of Rice Seeds for Dry Season 2024

Last November 14, 2024 the DA-LGU received 1,000 bags of certified rice seeds from PhilRice under Rice Competitiveness Enhancement containing 20 kgs/bag which is good for 282 hectares. It was utilized during **dry season** by 943 eligible rice farmers and reported as planted. In addition, we distributed 380 Knowledge Product Kits and 380 pieces 2025 calendar with 380 beneficiaries.

II - CORN AND CASSAVA PROGRAM

A. Master listing of Corn and Cassava Farmers

In the first quarter of the year, the office assigned Mr. Dolly M. Asis Jr. as Corn and Cassava Coordinator in eleven (11) barangays of this municipality. The aim is to monitor/ master listing of corn and cassava farmers, organized association, at end of the year 2024 the of list of corn and cassava farmers already updated with the total of 236 corn farmers and 319 cassava farmers based on the data submitted by each barangay.

B. Organized Association

Based on the record, and coordination with the barangay, we invited the corn and cassava farmers to attend the meeting and conduct election of officers to organize farmers association. Only four (4) barangays responded and successfully have an organized association.

Danao Norte Corn and Cassava Farmers Association (DNCCFA) with 23 members a DOLE registered association, Canyayo Cassava and Corn Planters Association (CAACOPA) with 18 members, Magsaysay Corn and Cassava Farmers Association (MaCCaFA) with 48 members and Mat-I Farmers Corn and Cassava Planters Association (MFCCPA) with 43 members.

C. Distribution of Corn Seeds

Since there is no allocated municipal budget for the purchase of corn seeds, The Municipal Agriculture Office requested to the DA Provincial Office for the allocation of corn seeds to our municipality and it is granted, after the delivery, we inform the target beneficiary in coordination with the Barangay and Organized Association the corn seeds dispersed immediately after the farmers signed the received form, mostly of the farmers received are from barangay's Mat-I, Magsaysay, Danao Norte and Canyayo due to there is already an organized association which is the first priority. And there is already an existing area for corn production.

D. Corn and Cassava Monitoring

In monitoring of area planted and harvested, it is conducted every two (2) weeks, to make an accurate technology adaptation. Planting and harvesting record for the first cropping season (January to June) a total area of 6.5 ha planted of inbred corn from barangay Canyayo, Danao Sur, Magsaysay, Mat-I and Poblacion and on second cropping (July to December) have a total area of 7 hectares Hybrid corn and 1-hectare inbred corn from barangay Canyayo, Danao Norte, Mat I, Magsaysay and Tabugon. Continues monitoring of the standing crop, market price of fresh corn and cassava, corn grits and crack corn are also done within the municipality have been conducted. Results after it is consolidated will be submitted to the Provincial Agriculture Office for their guidance, information and proper action.

III - HIGH VALUE COMMERCIAL CROPS (HVCC)

A) Vegetables Seeds

Vegetables Seeds from Department of Agriculture - MiMaRoPa

Department of Agriculture – MiMaRoPa funded 30 kilograms of assorted vegetables seeds with Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to Pandan Ati Farmers and Fishermen Association (PAFFA). The 30 kilograms of assorted vegetables seeds were divided into two. The other 15 kilograms were granted to PAFFA and the other half to the Municipal Agriculture Office and being used for the distribution of vegetables seeds to other active farmers associations, schools and barangay communal gardens. A total of 274 farmers benefited the program.

C. HVCDP Small-Scale Irrigation Facility

The Magsaysay Fishermen and Farmers Association was one of the beneficiaries of the Small-Scale Irrigation Facility project under HVC Development Program of the DA-Region Office. The project aims to help farmers association engaged in vegetable production to continually produce healthy, fresh and quality vegetables for their community even during the dry season. Also, to give livelihood to the farmer's association members engaged in vegetable farming, so to uplift their way of living.



The association was granted to have one (1) set of Pump and Irrigation System on Open Source (PISOS). The project intervention was implemented for C.Y. 2024 and was delivered last January 27, 2025.

The unit was installed at the communal garden of the association located in Brgy. Magsaysay, Santa Fe, Romblon. With the project intervention received by the

The project aimed to help Mango farmers to produce quality Mangoes, control production losses and to augment income in Mango production.

IV - LIVESTOCK (ANIMAL PRODUCTION AND MANAGEMENT)



In March 2024, the DA Regional Office undertook a thorough validation of beneficiaries for ASF indemnification. These dedicated hog raisers made the commendable choice to voluntarily surrender their hogs during the ASF outbreak, demonstrating their commitment to swiftly eradicating the infectious disease in the municipality. A total of 61 farmers were successfully validated, with the majority hailing from barangays Magsaysay, Pandan, Tabugon, Poblacion, Danao Sur, and Mat-I. By November 2024, these farmers received well-deserved indemnification assistance, thanks to the collaborative efforts of the Office of the Municipal Agriculture in Santa Fe, the DA Regional Office, and the Provincial Veterinary Office. This initiative not only supports our local farmers but also strengthens our collective fight against ASF, ensuring a healthier and more resilient agricultural community.

In response to the serious threat posed by African Swine Fever (ASF) and the accompanying restrictions on the importation of pork and pork products from infected zones, the municipality of Santa Fe has taken decisive action to safeguard local hog farmers. Recognizing the profound risks and impacts of ASF, a rigorous monitoring system for incoming and outgoing pork products has been established, thanks to a strong partnership between the municipal Agriculture Department and the provincial Veterinary Office. A dedicated quarantine officer from the Provincial Veterinary Office has been appointed to oversee operations at the port of Santa Fe.

As demonstrated in the figure above, shipments of tocino and longganisa from the province of Aklan, which were illegally imported, have been swiftly confiscated and condemned. This urgent response underscores our commitment to preventing the potential spread of ASF within our community and protecting our local agriculture industry.

This alarming event prompted a swift and decisive response from the SPEEDIER team, in partnership with the Municipal Health Office and the Municipal Agriculture Office. They immediately implemented comprehensive disease surveillance and monitoring within a 500-meter radius of the infected area. To protect the community, immediate dog vaccinations were conducted, and extensive information campaigns were launched in the barangay. These efforts aimed to raise awareness about rabies and provide essential guidance on how to respond effectively in the event of a dog bite, ensuring the safety and well-being of all residents.

A.1. Distribution of Livelihood assistance to Fisherfolks Associations

The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) thru the Office of Municipal Agriculture under the Special Area for Agriculture Development (SAAD) Program of BFAR MIMAROPA Conducted distribution of livelihood assistance to the Fisherfolks Community in our municipality particularly in terms of Capture Fishing, Postharvest and Aquaculture. SAAD is a program essentially anchored in poverty incidence reduction and local food production activation through livelihood assistance for marginalized fisher folks. The program is committed to the development of marginalized communities by improving their economic conditions through the creation of livelihood opportunities in the fishery sector.
